Aquatic Studies Summer Camp 2000

For Students Ages 9–15

Southwest Texas State University

Aquatic Studies Camp 2000 is offered in two formats. Eight, week-long resident camps and two, 2-day non-resident camps are offered. Coed and single sex sessions are available.

Camps I–VIII

These are one-week resident camps. Campers will spend a week at a supervised camp, in a university atmosphere. Room and board are provided. Mornings are devoted to educational activities related to the Edwards Aquifer, aquatic biology and water chemistry. Afternoons are filled with a variety of fun aquatic activities designed to enhance appreciation for aquatic resources, particularly groundwater.

Monday: Tubing on the San Marcos River

Tuesday: Scuba diving lesson and visit to SWT's Aquarena Center

Wednesday: Raft trip on the Guadalupe River near New Braunfels

Thursday: Fishing and swimming at Landa Park in New Braunfels

Friday: SeaWorld in San Antonio

All activities are supervised by faculty and staff members of Southwest Texas State University and by certified teachers. Scuba diving techniques are taught by certified diving instructors.

Enrollment:

Limited to 26 students per session, on a first come first served basis. A reservation is confirmed upon receipt of \$100 deposit. Full payment is due on or before the day of registration (for each session). The camps begin on Sunday afternoon and end on Saturday afternoon.

Tuition

\$500 per student (includes room, board, instruction and all activities for the week). There is a \$25 cancellation fee. (Entire deposit is forfeited if cancellation is not made at least 2 weeks before camp.)

Camps IX and X

These camps are 2-day sessions offered as non-resident day camps. Mornings and afternoons are devoted to educational activities related to the Edwards Aquifer, aquatic biology and water chemistry. Room and board are not provided.

Tuition

\$100.00 per student. Full payment must be received in advance to reserve a placement. There is a \$25 cancellation fee.
