



DIRECTIONS

- Heading South on IH35, take Aquarena Springs Drive Exit/Exit 206.
- Take right (heading West) on Aquarena Spring Drive.
- After crossing the San Marcos River bridge, turn right onto Sessoms Drive.
- Proceed through a four-way stop light, and continue driving until coming to a four-way stop at the intersection of Sessoms Drive and Comanche Street.
- Turn left on Comanche, staying in the left lane.
- After passing under pedestrian bridge, make a left turn on Talbot. The parking garage is on the left at the end of Talbot.
